


Car-Big industries begin to be created around auto

Popular in Southern BC




Airplane

Pilots did their own repairs
Crashed a lot
10 m high and 30km/hr-"silver dart"
J.A.D Mc Curdy-1st pilot
Only flew for about a 30 km/hr

Cdns greatest users of the telephone
1901 - 300, 000 phones in Canada
Companies hired children for errands
Offered wake-up calls



Wireless Radio
Frederick Fessenden transmitted 1st radio broadcast
Mainly used in shipping
Became famous after saving lives on the "Titanic"

Tommy Burns


1st Canadian to win heavyweight

Boat racer-world champion after 150 races




